Welcome to the Speaker Resources page for the [ISRII 14th Scientific Meeting](#). Below you will find detailed information about the various presentation formats available at the conference. Please review the guidelines carefully to ensure your presentation meets the expectations for each format.

Presentation Formats

General Guidelines for Oral Presentations

The guidelines below apply to all oral presentation formats: **Symposium, Themed Orals, Curated Orals, Featured Presentations, Panel Discussion, Lightning Round, and Mini-Symposium.**

- Room setup includes a podium, laptop, LCD projector, and screen.
- **Presentation Upload:** You must bring your presentation on a USB flash drive. You will need to load your slides onto the provided computer in the session room at least 15 minutes prior to your talk.
- Please check in with your session moderator at least 15 minutes before your session starts.
- We ask that you adhere strictly to your allotted time. Moderators have been instructed to ensure sessions stay on schedule and may need to intervene if a presentation exceeds the limit.
- **Slide Format:** Please prepare your PowerPoint slides in presentation mode, size 16:9 (widescreen).

Symposium

Symposia bring together multiple oral paper presentations under a unified theme, with a structured format curated by a session organizer.

- **Time Allotment:** 60-minute session
- **Structure:** May open with a brief organizer overview, followed by multiple individual presentations on a shared theme.

Themed Orals

Present your research as a stand-alone paper within a concurrent session, grouped with other presentations by a common topic area.

- **Time Allotment:** 10 minutes per presentation
- **Format:** Oral presentation; no question-and-answer period.

Curated Orals

Curated Orals highlight noteworthy research that has been selected and grouped by the program committee.

- **Time Allotment:** 10 minutes per presentation
 - **Format:** Oral presentation; no question-and-answer period.
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Featured Presentations

Featured Presentations highlight selected research of particular interest to the ISRII community.

- **Time Allotment:** 10 minutes per presentation
 - **Format:** Oral presentation; no question-and-answer period.
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Sounding Board

Sounding Board sessions create space for you to share early ideas, challenges, or projects and receive input from the audience.

- **Format:**
 - 1-2 minute introduction by each participant
 - Followed by open, small-group discussion with the audience
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Panel Discussion

Panels are dynamic, interactive sessions designed to spark audience engagement and dialogue around important topics.

- **Duration:** 60-minute session
 - **Format:** Informal, short presentations from invited panelists, followed by discussion.
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Lightning Round

Lightning Round sessions provide fast-paced research highlights grouped by theme.

- **Time Allotment:** 5 minutes per presentation
 - **Format:** Brief oral presentation; no question-and-answer period.
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Mini-Symposium

Mini-Symposia explore a focused theme through a small set of related presentations.

- **Duration:** 30-minute session
 - **Structure:** Three 10-minute presentations.
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Poster Presentation

Share your work visually on a poster board. Posters are ideal for visually rich data and fostering discussion, particularly for in-progress projects; there is no formal oral presentation for this format.

- **Format:** Visual presentation displayed on poster boards

Poster Dimensions

Poster boards this year are landscape-oriented and measure **2.4 m wide × 0.95 m high (7.87 ft × 3.12 ft)**; measurements do not include the board's support legs. Posters must be designed in landscape orientation to fit. Your printed poster should be slightly smaller than the board to allow for mounting without overlapping the edges.

Recommended Poster Size

- **Width:** 88–90 inches (approx. 224–229 cm)
- **Height:** 33–35 inches (approx. 84–89 cm)

This ensures a clean fit with a small margin (~2 in / 5 cm or so) around the edges of the board.

Design Recommendations

- Please design your poster to be visually engaging and legible to viewers in a conference setting.
- Use a font size that is easily readable from **2–3 feet away**. Minimum font sizes – Title: 85 pt, Subheadings: 36 pt, Body Text: 24 pt
- Ensure that the **poster title** and **author name(s)** are clearly displayed at the **top of the poster**.

Need Your Poster Printed?

For your convenience, several local print shops near the venue (Newcastle City Hall) can print your poster. We recommend contacting your chosen shop in advance to confirm file requirements, turnaround time, and pricing.

Demonstration

Demonstrations provide an interactive opportunity to showcase interventions, applications, devices, or digital tools in a hands-on environment.

- **Timing:** During the scheduled poster session
- **Format:** Hands-on, conversational format; a table and chairs are provided.
- **Examples:** Internet interventions, mobile apps, games
