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




Pilot Study

Participants:

- Similar to astronauts
 - Mean age 50 (SD = 9)
 - 4+ years college
- Minor depression (2 4 depression criteria)
- No other treatment
- R/O Substance Abuse; Antisocial PD
- N=14

Collaborating study: Massachusetts General Hospital Study (2008 - 2012) PI: Gary Strangman, PhD

- Infrared and MRI brain imaging of depression patients
- Revise depression treatment
- Randomized controlled clinical trial:
 Self-treatment vs. antidepressants

Participant Retention

- Experimental:
 - 0 dropouts, but 2 lapsed for >3 week interval between session 3 and 4
 - 0 no-shows for PST sessions
- Waitlist control:
 - 1 dropout (6 completers)
